Subject specific tours can be tailored to suit the needs of your group. A refreshing morning or afternoon tea can be arranged and coach parking is available. Wholesale rates and options for group tours are also available. Please enquire for details.

PRODUCTS

TOUR General Tour - 45mins

A great introduction to Wellington's social, cultural and maritime history. The general tour covers all 3 floors of the Museum and provides a quick overview of some of the Museums collection.

Ship 'n Chip Trip - 5hrs

Voyage through Wellington's history, harbour and nature. Start with a guided tour of the Museum and then ride the ferry to Matiu/ Somes Island, topped off with some classic kiwi fish' n chips (runs Mon-Fri excl Public Holidays).

Tales & Rails Tour - 2.5hrs

Start with a guided tour of the Museum then ride the historic Wellington Cable Car with a 'grip man'. Stop for refreshments at the Skyline Cafe, marvel at the best views of the city and then tour the Wellington Cable Car Museum (runs Mon-Fri excluding Public Holidays).

Capital Culture- Our Art - 4hrs

Half day arts and heritage tours showcase early Maori art forms, the evolution of the nation's art collection and our identity and more contemporary works, along with large sculptural art in the cityscape. Including refreshments.

Children's Paddy Tour - 45mins

Ages 3-7. Join your host on a journey to rediscover the exciting life of Paddy the Wanderer and friends! Meet King Dick the lion and hear about Paddy's encounter with a shark!

Children's Bingo Tour - 45mins

Ages 6-14. An interactive and engaging tour for older children. Listen out for key words whilst exploring Wellington's history with your host. First child to get Bingo receives a prize!

Children's Collection Hunt - 1hr

Age 10+. Follow the clues provided by your host to locate letters and clues hidden in the Museum Exhibitions. Answer the questions correctly and rearrange the letters to find your way to treasure!

Scavenger Hunt - approx 45mins

All ages. Have an adventure along the Wellington waterfront and back to the Museum at your own pace. Ideal for large groups and ESOL students.
